Practical Checklist & Visitor Guide

Everything you need to know before your day at the forge.

What to Wear

✓ **Wear natural fibre clothing:**

- Cotton, denim or wool
- Avoid polyester or synthetic fabrics (they can melt near heat)

✓ **Wear sturdy footwear:**

- Closed-toe shoes or boots
- No sandals or open footwear

✓ **Dress in layers:**

- The workshop can feel cold, but very hot near the forges
- Multiple layers allow you to adjust comfortably during the day

Natural fibres = safer, more comfortable, and recommended by professional blacksmiths.
